CSOPA /o Delafontaine 99 Legendary Circle 3ye Brook, NY 1057. **Open Call for Portraits:** All portrait artists able to deliver and pick up selected entries to The Bendheim Gallery may submit. Shipments will not be accepted. CSOPA membership is not required to enter.

Works Eligible: Portrait paintings, drawings and sculpture not previously exhibited with CSOPA and completed within the past three years are eligible. Paintings must be framed and wired for hanging with size limit 41" maximum horizontally including frame. No easels. Artists should provide display stands for sculpture. Artwork must be available for the duration of the exhibition (Jan. 31-Feb. 28). Submissions must be in digital format 72 dpi via email to csocietyopa@aol.com. Submission does not guarantee selection by the CSOPA committee for the exhibit & judging. Substitutions and late entries will not be accepted.

Submission Deadline: Submissions must be received on or before December 15, 2005

Notification: A list of accepted works will be emailed Tuesday, January 10, 2006 to those artists whose works will be included in the exhibition.

Receiving: Tuesday, Jan. 31, 10am-12noon (Snowdate Feb. 1) at The Bendheim Gallery in the Greenwich Arts Council building at 299 Greenwich Avenue. Artwork must be hand-delivered and unpacked.

Weekend Workshops Cancellation and Refund Policy: If a registered workshop participant must cancel, a full refund of workshop fees for both days will be made if - and only if - the request to cancel is received on or before January 4, 2006. If the GAC must close due to inclement weather, then programs for that day will be cancelled and registration fees will be fully refunded for each day of closure. Check website www.csopa.org for building closures. There will be no refund for the slide critique entrance fee except in the event of a Sunday program cancellation.

Judging: Judging the exhibition for awards are celebrated portraitists *Everett* Raymond Kinstler and Charles Reid.

Portfolios: Standard 9" x 12" portfolios of selected participating artists may be delivered with your painting(s) at receiving. Kindly limit the photos in your portfolio to your 12 best portraits. Please label the spine with your name for display. Business cards and price lists may be neatly included.

GAC Membership: Artists are invited to join our host organization. See www.greenwicharts.org.

Reception & CSOPA Patron Awards: Friday, February 3, 6pm - 8pm at the prestigious Bendheim Gallery. Cash prizes for "First", "Second" and "Third," plus ribbons for "Honorable Mention" and "Certificates of Merit" will be awarded at judges' discretion.

Lectures & Demonstrations Feb 4 & 5: Presenters include Igor Babailov, Foster Caddell, Michael Del Priore, Marvin Mattelson, Mary Minifie, and Richard Whitney. Commissions: Art for sale is encouraged. 30% is due to The Bendheim Gallery for sales and commissions made during and up to six months following the show. A voluntary 10-15% donation to CSOPA for commissions resulting from the exhibit would be used to fund future CSOPA events.

Removal: All art MUST be picked up on **Sunday, Feb. 26 between 3pm-5pm.** Works not removed at this time will be held at CSOPA for a storage fee of \$10/day at the artist's risk.
